BARGAINING REPORT #1

February 9th, 2023

As is common knowledge, your Bargaining Committee met with Company representatives and with that, the process to complete the first agreement between CWA Local 3010 and Liberty Communications of Puerto Rico officially started. Both committees were introduced by both parties and the chairs were established. The Union presented a proposal for the bargaining rules that will regulate the process, with the intention of addressing the complaints received by the members, more promptly and with full availability, 24/7, to meet with the Company. Also, the Union requested the approval of the time worked and invested for all members of the Bargaining Committee, an issue that has been a really great challenge these last few months. Your Committee presented proposals that have the intention to address some of our claims. The submitted proposals make reference to: Article 15, Article 6, Article 10, Article 17, Article 25, and Article 16 of our current Collective Bargaining Agreement. These are still waiting for a reply from the Company.

From their end, the Company has not been wanting to recognize the tradition and practice between the parties. Still, a date for a second Bargaining session was able to be scheduled; where we hope to obtain an answer and progress for both parties.
